December 13, 2011

The monthly meeting of Covington Town Board was held on Tuesday December 13, 2011 at the Covington Town Building. Present were Councilpersons Larry Warren, Paul Tobias, Brian Murphy and Sharon West. Also present was Supervisor Jerry Davis, Town Clerk Amy Wiedrich, Zoning Officer Alan Rudgers and Highway Superintendent Mike Bell. Book keeper Deb Long was also present.

The Pledge of allegiance opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m..

On a motion of Councilperson West, seconded by Councilperson Warren the following resolution was
