Monthly Meeting of Covington Town Board
May 8, 2018

The monthly meeting of Covington Town Board was held on Tuesday May 8, 2018 at the town hall. Present were Councilpersons Paul Tobias, Rod Cummins, Larry Warren and Sharon West.
